

## Resolution

A Resolution classifying rates for the 9-1-1 Emergency Service Fee on Service Users for local exchange access lines and equivalent local exchange access lines

WHEREAS, the El Paso County 911 District Board of Managers is authorized by the Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 772.314 to impose a 9-1-1 emergency service fee on users for local exchange access lines and equivalent local exchange access lines;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 771.063, the El Paso County 911 District Board of Managers is required to follow the definition of a local exchange access line and an equivalent local exchange access line as adopted by rule by the Commission on State Emergency Communications;

WHERAS, in accordance with the Texas Health and Safety Code Chapter 772.314(c), the rate of the fee may not exceed six percent of the monthly base rate charged a service user in a service year by the principal service supplier in the participating jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Texas Health and Safety Code Chapter 772.314(d), the Board shall set the amount of the fee each year as a part of the annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of fee rates and classifications recommended by District management for Fiscal Year 2025 complies with the six percent cap in Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 772.314(d),

NOW THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MANAGERS OF THE EL PASO COUNTY 911 DISTRICT THAT: The 9-1-1 emergency service fee rates and classifications for FY2025 are hereby levied at the following monthly rates:

\$1.38 per line per month for residential lines,

\$4.46 per line per month for a business line and business trunks.
